

As of the writing of this statement, the entire State of Pennsylvania has moved to the Green Phase of reopening according to the governor's plan. However, since that time, the governor has unilaterally implemented additional statewide restrictions against the bar and restaurant industry specifically to address upticks in COVID cases in select counties. According to the State guidelines, the following must be observed by the restaurant and guests:

- 6-foot distance between tables
- No more than 10 guests at a table.
- Customers MUST wear masks or facial coverings at all times when not seated at their table. This includes while traveling to and using the restrooms and entering and exiting the building.
- Customers must be seated at a table to be served.
- Indoor dining must be limited to 25% capacity, not including outdoor dining (for us, this amounts to about 65 customers at any given time). Also, there is to be no seating at the bar.
- Food must be purchased in order to receive alcoholic beverage service.
- Customers are not to be served any additional alcoholic beverages after their meal has concluded.

We understand the difficulty and inconvenience this places upon our customers, however, we are threatened by the State of Pennsylvania with fines and suspension of our liquor license for violations in the mandates issued by the State. It has therefore been made the responsibility of our management and employees to enforce the mandate. Therefore, we ask that anyone willing to patronize our restaurant for the time being also be willing to follow the mandates as written, especially in regard to wearing a mask or facial covering. If you are not able to, we are still offering takeout food, beer and cocktails-to-go as we are allowed to under the current mandate, so we suggest this as an alternative.
