



As Northampton County moves from the Red to Yellow phase of reopening, we wanted to take the time to update our customers on what has been going on behind the scenes at Scorecard in order to protect our customers and employees at the time when we are allowed to welcome them back. Starting Friday, June 5th, we will be able to extend patio dining service to our customers with restrictions. The dining room and bar are to remain closed at this time. According to the State guidelines, the following must be observed by the restaurant and guests:

- 6-foot distance between tables
- No more than 10 guests at a table.
- Customers must be seated at a table to be served
- Single-serve condiments to be provided upon request
- Disposable single-use menus
- The restaurant will only be open to thru-traffic (i.e., going to restrooms, entering/exiting the building).

In addition to this, Scorecard has performed MANY upgrades and changes to policies in order to keep our customers and employees safe. These include:

- Installation of hand sanitizer dispensers at each entrance and staff areas.
- Increased daily sanitation including daily sanitizing of common touch points such as point-of-sale computers, door handles, bathroom fixtures, pens and writing implements (between each guest), check presenters (between guests), tables, chairs and more.
- Installation of high-grade HVAC filters and duct cleaning, where possible.
- Increased hand-washing and sanitation training for staff members.
- Daily staff temperature screening and exclusion, if necessary.

While in the YELLOW phase, we ask our customers to please adhere to/understand these procedures:

- Reservations for patio tables will be HIGHLY recommended.
- Any customer who wishes to be served MUST be seated at a table.
- Masks must be worn by customers while in the facility, except when seated at their table.
- Food served on the patio will be served in disposable containers, which can be removed from the premises if unfinished.
- If a table is not available when you arrive, we will do our best to give a reasonable estimate of time until a table becomes available. If you choose to wait for a table, you will be asked to wait

outside in the parking lot or your vehicle until your table is ready. We will also request a phone number so we can text or call you when your table is ready.

- Until the Green phase begins, draft beer will not be available and certain menu items may not be available or offered due to either cost or availability of product.

We know that many of our loyal customer are anxious to get back to some sense of normalcy and going out to eat is a staple of American life that we're happy to provide. We will do our best to get back to business-as-usual while working within the new rules and regulations that we are expected to follow. All we ask is for your understanding as we comply with these new rules. Welcome back!
